Declaration of Interest Statement

Authors have a responsibility to disclose interests that might appear to affect their ability to present data objectively. These include relevant financial (for example patent ownership, stock ownership, consultancies, speaker's fees), personal, political, intellectual, or religious interests.

The International Life Sciences Institute expects authors to disclose any financial relationship that might be construed as a conflict of interest significant enough to influence the results or interpretation of articles accepted for publication in *Nutrition Reviews*. Generally accepted guidelines consider interests of \$10,000 or 5% equity in a company to be significant. These sources of financial support can include research funding, stocks, shares, consultation fees, and patents or patent applications. Diversified mutual funds or investment trusts do not constitute a conflict of interest for these purposes.

If there is doubt about whether an interest is relevant or significant, it is prudent to disclose. Readers will benefit from transparency, including knowing authors' and contributors' affiliations and interests. Sources of funding for research or publication should always be disclosed. Authors should routinely include information about research funding in all papers they prepare for publication. Where a clinical trial registration number is available, this should be included.
